



The 1969-1970 era was filled with memorable happenings both "in" and "out" of school. Here are some of the highlights of that most important time period:

POLITICS & WORLD AFFAIRS:

Vietnam scored most of the news stories in 1969-1970...In November '69 the casualty list topped 300,000...Demonstrators numbering 250,000 gathered in Washington, in opposition to the war... Lt. Cally was charged with murder in the My Lai Massacre... and the Kent State student demonstration grabbed headlines across the country when 4 students died in an anti-war demonstration. In Helsinki, the SALT talks commenced... The U.S. Postal Service experienced the first strike in its 195-year history, lasting an agonizing eight days in March 1970... France's Charles DeGaulle died at 80, Egypt's President Nassar died at 52, and North Vietnam President Ho Chi Minh died.

OTHER HEADLINES: The Ted Kennedy/Mary Jo Kopechne story made the news again when an exhumation request was denied... A Southern Airways DC-9 crash killed 75, including 43 Marshall University football players and coaches... Pope Paul VI was attacked in Manila's airport by a knife-wielding would-be assassin... Mother nature struck in the form of a cyclone in Bangladesh, and Peru suffered the "most historic earthquake in the Western Hemisphere" with some 50,000 lives lost, another 20,000 missing.

CRIMELINE UPDATE: Charles Manson was indicted by a Grand Jury in the Sharon Tate Murders...UMW official, Joseph Yablonski, his wife and daughter were found shot to death in their Pennsylvania home...The Chicago Seven were convicted of crossing state lines to incite riots.

SPACE & OUTERSPACE: Charles "Pete" Contrad, Jr., Alan Bean & Richard Gordon, aboard Apollo 12, experienced our second successful landing on the moon...The US Air Force concluded a 21 year study of UFO's and stated their findings..."no evidence of extra-terrestrial

space ships" found. (ET are you there?)

FIRSTS: First calculator sold...First sensor-activated artificial leg and nuclear-powered heart pacemaker...First quadraphonic records and tapes were marketed.

THE ECONOMY: On an average income of just under \$10,000, Americans were spending \$23,400 for a 3-bedroom home; \$3,579 for a new Ford, and \$1.32 for a gallon of milk, 36¢ per gallon for gasoline and 24¢ for a loaf of bread.

ON THE BOOKSHELVES: Lots and lots of great stuff to read...Puzo's The Godfather; Susann's The Love Machine; Vonnegut's eerie Slaughterhouse Five; Chrichton's The Andromeda Strain; MacLean's Force 10 From Navarrone; Dickey's Deliverance; Hemingway's Islands In The Stream; Segal's unforgettable Love Story to name a few

SPORTS...GO TEAM GO: American League Baltimore Orioles prevailed in the World Series 4 games to 1 over Cincinnati's Reds...In The Super Bowl, the Kansas City Chiefs dominated the Minnesota Vikings 23-7...Hockey's Stanley Cup went to the Boston Bruins, besting St. Louis for the title...New York took the NBA Championship title over Los Angeles. Ken Rosewall and Margaret Court finished in the winners circle at the U.S. Open...Golf's PGA championship went to Dave Stockton, the U.S. Open to Tony Jacklin, and the coveted Masters to Billy Casper...In the Kentucky Derby, Dust Commander crossed the finish line first with jockey Manganello aboard, but the Preakness went to Personality and the Belmont to High Echelon.
